



Most Famous Mountain Peaks Interlaken – Lötschberger Tunnel – Zermatt

A fantastic journey to two of the most popular mountain tops in Switzerland: Jungfrauoch and Gornergrat. Both offer incredible views of fascinating mountains and glaciers like the Matterhorn, Mont Blanc and the Aletsch Glacier – Europe’s longest glacier at 22 km. Overnights are in two famous yet contrasting Swiss resorts: Interlaken and Zermatt. Interlaken is situated in the heart of the Bernese Oberland and surrounded by green alpine meadows and snow-capped mountains. Zermatt with the impressive Matterhorn towering in the background is the other world famous holiday destination on your trip.

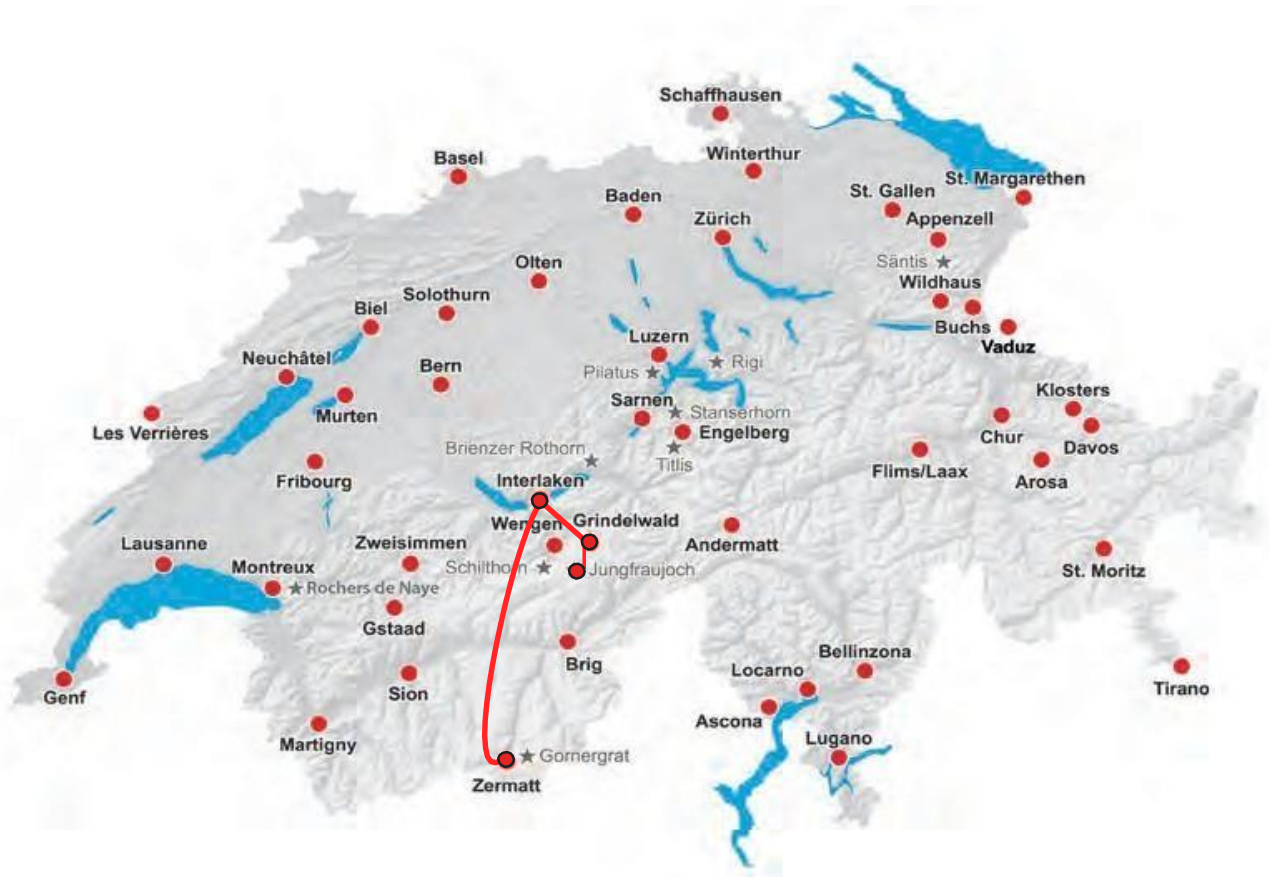
Included services

Day 1: Arrival Interlaken

Transfer by train from the border, airport or any other destination in Switzerland to Interlaken. Short walk from the railway station to your hotel. Depending on arrival time, take the opportunity to discover the town. Interlaken lies in the Bernese Oberland on an alluvial plain, between Lake Thun and Lake Brienz. The resort, which is presided over by the three mighty mountains, Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau, is the starting point for numerous activities. Overnight in Interlaken.

Day 2: Interlaken / Excursion Jungfrauoch

The Jungfrau Railway, which leads through the heart of the mountains and up to the highest train station in Europe (3454 m), offers unbelievable views of the mountain giants Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau and of the longest river of ice in the Alps – the Aletsch glacier of 22 km length. Overnight in Interlaken.

Day 3: Interlaken – Zermatt via Lötscherberger Tunnel or Mountain Route

You have two options, you can either take the Lötschberg base tunnel directly to Visp and then on to Zermatt or in Interlaken, you board the train to Spiez from where you change to the Lötschberger panoramic train, which will take you through spectacular mountain scenery from the Bernese Oberland to the Valais and Visp, from where you continue to your next destination, Zermatt. Enjoy the picturesque landscape along the way. Overnight in Zermatt.

Day 4: Zermatt / Excursion Gornergrat

After breakfast, begins the excursion by cogwheel train to the Gornergrat where you will have superb views of the Matterhorn, Mont Blanc and other snow-capped peaks rising above 4000 m. The Matterhorn and Switzerland are inseparably linked to each other. The pyramid shaped colossus of a mountain, which is very difficult to climb, is said to be the most photographed mountain in the world. The Klein-Matterhorn ("Little Matterhorn"), which can be reached via a funicular, lies adjacent to the Matterhorn. Overnight in Zermatt.

Day 5: Departure

After breakfast, you will have some time to wander around Zermatt. The village lies at the foot of the Matterhorn. The town's touristic development is closely linked to what is most probably the world's most famous mountain. The resort is a car-free zone, has preserved its original character and offers nearly unlimited possibilities as far as excursions are concerned. Transfer by rail to the border/airport or on to your next holiday destination.
